



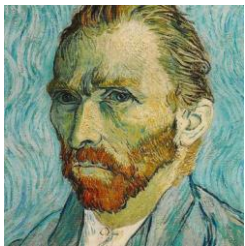
History

Facts: Isleworth is a small town of Saxon origin sited within the London Borough of Hounslow in west London, England. Isleworth's original area of settlement, alongside the Thames, is known as 'Old Isleworth'. Lower Square and Church Street still have buildings dating from the 18th and early 19th centuries. There used to be a film studio in Worton Road, Isleworth. Known as Worton Hall Studios and Isleworth Studios.

We will be looking at how we can take care of our local environment. In 2015, pollution levels produced by cars were recorded at nearly twice the legal limit in Isleworth!



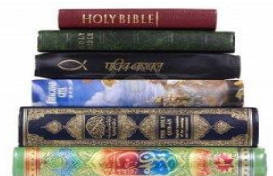
Science:
